ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, CHAPTER 80 FOR FIELD USE FEES

RESOLUTION #46-2011:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR LAWN SERVICES

The Township of Washington has a need for lawn services for foreclose properties. This Resolution would authorize the Township to go out to bid for this service. A lien is placed on the property for the service.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a the Township may purchase any goods or services under the State of NJ Cooperative Purchasing Program without going out to bid. DeHart & Sons, Inc., and Peach Country Tractor
