AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A CHAPTER OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, CHAPTER 260-VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP TO CREATE AN ACCIDENT REVIEW AND PREVENTION PANEL

This Ordinance establishes an Accident Review Panel in effort to reduce the Township's Worker's Compensation experience rate and establishes a policy for all accidents to ensure they are reviewed in a timely fashion and they are reviewed with a focus on the root cause of the accident and identifying corrective actions to prevent the accident or a similar type accident in the future. This Ordinance has been recommended by the JIF.

The Resolution amends the developer's agreement with Virtua and the Township of Washington for the donation of two athletic fields. The amendment memorializes a \$12,500 donation to be used toward the installation of an irrigation system for the fields.

RESOLUTION #75-2011: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER FOR THE FURNISHING OF HEALTH SERVICES

This resolution will authorize the County of Gloucester to perform all health services for the Township of Washington for the purpose of meeting the public health needs of the Township of Washington. This service is provided by funding thru the State of New Jersey.

RESOLUTION #76-2011: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX REFUNDS

Tax overpayments to accounts occur when payment is received from two sources, such as a mortgage company and a title company or when a senior citizen or veteran deduction is granted to a resident and their taxes are already paid, or when the County Tax Board Judgment or New Jersey State Tax Court Judgment reducing the assessment on the property, therefore reducing the amount of taxes due for the year. This Resolution authorizes a refund of the payments.

RESOLUTION #77-2011: A RESOLUTION AWARDED THE 2011/2012 SENIOR LUNCHEON PROGRAM CONTRACT TO MASSO'S CATERING

The Resolution awards a contract to Masso's Catering for the 2011/2012 Senior lunch program in the amount of \$4.50 per meal.
