Due to recent Court decisions some provisions of the Township Peace and Good Order Ordinance have to be revised to ensure that they are constitutional and not pre-empted by State Law.

**ORDINANCE #14-2011:** ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 186 ENTITLED RESIDENTIAL  
**Public Hearing** PARKING PERMITS

To address concerns of residents on Whitman School Drive regarding parking issues created by the proximity to the Whitman School this Ordinance will implement a residential parking permit system during the school year and during school hours. This will be no cost to the residents and will ensure that street parking will be available to the residents and their guests.
